




Single Hole Lavatory Faucet

assembly instructions

- 1. Be sure water supply lines are turned to the off position. If applicable, remove existing faucet.
- 2. Clean surface of lavatory sink before installing new faucet.
- 3. Make sure drain in closed or blocked so that small parts do not fall into drain.
- 4. Install new faucet body assembly into the hole of the sink. Tighten mounting nut from underneath sink. Connect water supply line to faucet.



- 5. Remove the aerator from faucet before using for the first time. Allow both hot and cold water to run for one minute. Replace aerator.
- 6. Use teflon tape to connect drain body to tube.



7. Install drain of sink.


